RULES

- (1) **“Own Choice”** repertoire (which must include a march) is to be of **15 minutes maximum** performance time for Intermediate and Senior categories and **12 minutes for Junior category**. There will be a special prize in all categories for the inclusion of an **optional** celebratory piece to mark July the 4th.
- (2) Setting-up time is 10 minutes max.
- (3) **Any band which exceeds specified times will be penalised.**

Marking guidelines are as follows:

Tune and intonation	10 marks
Rhythm and co-ordination	10 marks
Choice of programme	10 marks
Balance	10 marks
Presentation/Stage deportment	10 marks
General assessment of performance	50 marks

Any band which has previously won a junior or intermediate grade **must** compete in a higher grade.

Bands which have entered in a lower grade than the one in which they have previously competed are requested to submit a list of musicians for the adjudicators.

A maximum of three players, who are not permanent members of the particular band playing, may be included for competition purposes on condition that they are declared prior to the competition.
